How to reach Genova and public transportation

The Department of Economics at the University of Genova is located at Via Vivaldi 5, 16126, Genova (Italy). Here is a comprehensive guide on how to reach the Department using different modes of transportation.

BY AIR

From Genova Cristoforo Colombo Airport (GOA)

- 1. **Taxi**: Taxis are available outside the airport terminal. The journey to the Department takes approximately 15-20 minutes, depending on traffic.
- 2. Public Transport:

Bus: Take the Volabus, a shuttle service from the airport to the city center. Get off at **Genova Piazza Principe train station** and walk 5 minutes to the Department.

Airlink: This service connects the airport with **Sestri Ponente Aeroporto** train station. From there, you can take a train to **Genoa Piazza Principe** (approximately 10 minutes journey) and continue to the department walking.

BY TRAIN

From Genova Piazza Principe Train Station

 Walking: The Department is approximately 5-10 minutes from the train station.

From Genoa Brignole Train Station

- Taxi: Taxis are available outside the station. The journey takes about 15 minutes.
- 2. Public Transport:
 - Metro: Take the metro from Brignole towards Brin, and get off at Darsena. Walk to Via Vivaldi (approximately 6 minutes).



 Bus: Take Bus No. 18 or 20 from the station, stopping at Via Balbi. From there, it's a short walk to the department.

BY CAR

From Milan

• Take the A7 motorway towards Genoa and exit at **Genova Ovest**. Follow signs to the city center and then towards **Via Vivaldi**.

From Eastern Liguria

• Take the A12 motorway and exit at **Genova Est**. Follow the directions to the city center towards **Via Vivaldi 5**.

From Turin

- Take the A21 motorway from Turin towards Alessandria.
- Merge onto the A26 motorway towards Genoa.
- Follow signs for the A10 motorway and continue towards Genoa.
- Exit at Genova Ovest and follow signs to the city center and Via Vivaldi 5.

From Ventimiglia

- Take the A10 motorway eastbound towards Genoa.
- Continue on the A10 and exit at Genova Ovest.
- Follow signs to the city center and then towards Via Vivaldi.

PARKING

Parking around the university is limited, but there are a few options available:

- Piazza della Vittoria: A large parking area with good access to public transport to reach the department (cheapest option).
- **Posteggio Acquario**: Located near the Aquarium of Genoa, this parking lot is convenient for reaching the department and the city center.
- **Posteggio Darsena**: Situated close to the university, this parking area is another good option if space is available.

It is advisable to use public transportation from these parking areas to reach the department efficiently.

BY BUS AND METRO

- The local bus network, operated by **AMT Genova**, provides several lines that connect different parts of the city to the university. The most convenient lines are No. 18, 20, and 35.
- The Darsena metro station is located nearby, providing additional access to the department. You can
 take the metro line from other parts of the city and get off at Darsena station, which is within walking
 distance to the department.

Tickets

Tickets for buses and the metro can be purchased at tobacco shops, newsstands, or from ticket machines at metro stations. You can also buy and validate tickets using the **AMT app**, available for download on iOS and Android devices. This app provides a convenient way to plan your journey and stay updated on the latest schedules.
